In 2010 our vision at Evergreen Community Church is to get a little support from a lot of people so we can pack and **ship one million meals** (at only 11 cents per meal) to children in Haiti.

The approach is simple: children and adults at Evergreen hand-pack meals formulated specially for starving children, and we ship the meals to Haiti.



These meals will be distributed to 4500 children attending 17 schools that were built and are operated by a non-profit organization called Lifeline Haiti (www.lifelinehaiti.com).

By providing the basic necessities of life, we can help them survive today, while they receive an education which will help them survive tomorrow.

We can help them survive today, and help each child receive an education which will help them thrive tomorrow.

Through Lifeline Haiti these children are given food, clean water, medical care and an education. They are being trained to become self-sufficient adults—able to take care of not only themselves but also their families and the people of their country.

As the poorest country in the Western

Hemisphere, Haiti and its population of nearly nine million people make up a number of statistics that we should never see in our modern lifetime.

- 54% are without clean drinking water.
- 49% are malnourished.
- 45% are illiterate
- The average income for the majority of working adults is \$1/day or less.

Living in such extreme poverty, many of the people of Haiti **have lost hope** that they will ever experience a better life. With your help we can give these people hope for a better future where food is plentiful, health is assured and where **their hard work can result in more than just a meager existence.**

There is a 1 cent per meal administration fee assessed by Kids Against Hunger, the non-profit organization that sends us the food and packing materials.
